Chief Secretary Durgashankar Mishra, while addressing the press conference after visiting the stalls of the Uttar Pradesh pavilion, said that an online trade fair is also going to be held in Uttar Pradesh on the 16th, in which sitting right here in Banaras, Jaunpur, Banda You can also order online from anywhere by sitting at one place i.e. viewing our Uttar Pradesh products online. The Chief Secretary told that in different regions of Uttar Pradesh, whether it is the region of Bundelkhand or the region of West or the region of Ruhelkhand, each region has different types of dishes, sweets, snacks, etc. are food festivals. It has been kept through which more and more people can connect with Uttar Pradesh. He further told that our state i.e. Uttar Pradesh has been given status as focus state in which 2 states are Uttar Pradesh and Kerala. The Chief Secretary said that all the policies that we have in Uttar Pradesh, whether it is the policy of the industry or the policy of MSME or any other policy, all the policies have been revised and reviewed through which we are doing well in the country. We are making a good policy so that investors get such an environment so that more and more investors can invest in Uttar Pradesh because our infrastructure has become good at present and at present 6 expressways and 7 expressways have been built in Uttar Pradesh. But work is going on now, we have metro running

in five cities each and 50 destinations of the country are connected through airports from 9 places. Referring to the corridor, he said that the largest part of the Fred corridor goes to Uttar Pradesh, both of which are cut in Dadri. Referring to Banaras in Uttar Pradesh, he said that the waterways from Banaras to Haldia are also in Uttar Pradesh, which is an investment. There is a way to focus investment in Uttar Pradesh by promoting infrastructure, which works to create a positive environment for investment in Uttar Pradesh and the investors who come to Uttar Pradesh will also give information from Noida, Greater Noida, Yamuna Authority, which by welcoming the investor, he will also give information related to investment and will try and help him to get maximum investment so that the work of increasing the economy of Uttar Pradesh by 4 times in the next 5 years can be done. He said that after talking to all the stalls set up in Uttar Pradesh Pavilion, it seems that there is a great enthusiasm to invest in them because Uttar Pradesh is a changing state. Praising the Prime Minister, he said that Honorable Prime Minister Narendra Amrit Kaal has started under the leadership of Modi ji, which is going to develop into a new Uttar Pradesh to make Uttar Pradesh a developed country. 101 stalls have been set up in Uttar Pradesh Pavilion through ADOP from various districts in Uttar Pradesh. Notes on Statement of Standalone unaudited Financial Results for the quarter and half year ended 30th September, 2022:  
1. The above results which are published in accordance with regulations 33 of the SEBI (LODR) Regulations 2015, have been reviewed by the Audit committee and approved by the Board of Directors in their meeting held on 14.11.2022.  
2. The Financial results are in accordance with the Accounting Standards as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules 2015 and relevant amendments therefor.  
3. The company has identified primary business segments in manufacturing of Corrugated Boards & Boxes, Duplex Cartons and such other Paper Boards and Cartons. However the company is also manufacturing Food and Dairy Products.  
4. The company had received certain concerns with respect to matters of corporate governance and other procedural aspects of financial accounting of the company from one of Director of the company Sh Sanjeev Khemka. The Management and other directors are continuously trying to resolve these concerns. Further Sh Sanjeev Khemka has filed petition on dated 16.09.2022 before the Hon'ble National Company Law Tribunal, New Delhi via 241 & 242 of the Companies Act, 2013, which is pending for disposal. Further, we believe that there would be no impact of the same on these financial results.  
5. The company has outstanding investment in equity shares of its related party company M/s KCL Milk Products India Pvt Ltd of Rs. 49 Lacs, however, net worth of such company has been eroded as per latest audited financial statement available. The Company has not evaluated whether any impairment provision is required for expected credit losses in accordance with Ind AS 109 - "Financial Instruments" due to uncertainty of recovery on disposal of said assets.  
6. Time period of Loans given & outstanding as at 30.09.2022 to its related party company M/s KCL Milk Products India Pvt Ltd amounting to Rs.991.83 Lacs, is not defined / available, however, based on internal assessment, the management believes that this inter corporate outstanding loan will be realised, therefore the same has not been discounted in accordance with Ind AS 109 - "Financial Instruments".  
7. A wholly owned subsidiary company namely M/s KCL Paper Mill Private Limited, owned by M/s KCL LTD was incorporated on 21.04.2021, however, no business operations in the subsidiary company was started for the period ended on 30.09.2022.
